



Terms and Conditions

All participants must wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD (personal floatation device) while operating paddle craft. Per Rhode Island law adopted in 2023, violators may be subject to a \$100 fine by the Coast Guard, DEM or Harbormaster.

Be sure to let us know if you have any special requests as to sizing and outfitting of equipment. For example, if you need more leg room, we will outfit you with the right kayak. Please do not exceed the capacity (weight limits) of our boats and boards.

Must be 18 years of age or older to rent a kayak. Parents and guardians are solely responsible for minors while on the water.

All participants must complete a waiver form. One form is required for each participant. A parent or legal guardian must complete a waiver form for each participant under the age of 18.

Participants are responsible for lost, stolen or damaged equipment. Please do your best to store equipment when not in use in a safe place away from the water and high tide line. We can provide padlocks and cables by request for added security while leaving equipment unattended.

Narrow River Kayaks reserves the right to cancel or postpone any rentals or outings due to inclement or unsafe conditions. In cases when we cancel your reservation, we will offer a credit to reschedule or issue a full refund.

If you decide to cancel your reservation and cannot reschedule, you will be charged a flat rate cancellation fee of \$10. All cancellations within 24 hours of your reservation will be charged the \$10 fee to cover processing fees. We realize that sometimes circumstances arise that are beyond your control. Just let us know.
